★ THREE AMENDMENTS THAT WOULD PERMANENTLY REWRITE THE VIRGINIA CONSTITUTION ★

01 THIS IS NOT ABOUT "REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM" IT IS ABORTION WITHOUT LIMITS

BALLOT LANGUAGE

Shall Section 15-A.1 of Article I of the Constitution of Virginia be amended to establish that all persons have a fundamental right to reproductive freedom, including the ability to make and carry out decisions about pregnancy, including abortion, contraception, prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, miscarriage management, and fertility care; to continue one's pregnancy; to make decisions about adoption; and to receive care without discrimination?



WHAT IT DOES

1. Creates a constitutional right to abortion for "every individual" including minors.
2. Allows 1 physician, without consultation, to determine if the pregnancy may affect the health or mental health of the mother (in the third trimester).
3. Protects individuals who aid or assist another individual to have an abortion.



WHY VOTE NO

1. **EXPANDS THE CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT**
Creates a broad constitutional right to abortion for "every individual," including minors, at any stage of pregnancy.
2. **THIRD-TRIMESTER STANDARD**
Allows 1 physician, who financially benefits from performing the abortion, to decide if the mother's health or mental health is at risk—with no second opinion required.
3. **PROTECTS THOSE WHO FACILITATE**
Protects anyone who aids or assists an abortion, opening the door for abusers and traffickers to facilitate abortions to destroy evidence.

02 THIS IS NOT ABOUT "MARRIAGE" IT IS GENDER IDEOLOGY

BALLOT LANGUAGE

Shall Section 15-A of Article I of the Constitution of Virginia be amended to establish that only a union between one man and one woman may be a marriage recognized by law in Virginia, and that this section may not be construed to prohibit the Commonwealth or any political subdivision from recognizing other relationships?



WHAT IT DOES

1. Redefines marriage in the constitution as only between one man and one woman.
2. Prevents the constitution from being interpreted to require the government to recognize other relationships.
3. Protects religious liberty and the freedom of individuals, organizations, and businesses to express their beliefs.



WHY VOTE NO

1. **NOT ABOUT MARRIAGE**
Goes beyond marriage. Creates a gender ideology that separates sex from gender, redefining "man" and "woman" in the Virginia Constitution.
2. **UNDERMINES RELIGIOUS LIBERTY**
Forces the government and individuals to accept definitions of gender that conflict with deeply held beliefs.
3. **FUTURE LEGAL RISKS**
This new language could be used in the future to expand legal claims based on gender identity, putting parental rights, educators, businesses, and organizations at greater risk.

BALLOT LANGUAGE

Shall Section 6 of Article II of the Constitution of Virginia be amended to establish that no one shall be denied, restricted, or conditioned in the right to vote because of convictions for nonviolent felonies or offenses arising from nonfelonious conduct?



WHAT IT DOES

1. Automatically restores voting rights the moment a person is released from incarceration.
2. Requires no additional action—no waiting period, no fines paid, no restitution made.
3. Applies to all serious felonies without distinguishing by the gravity of the crime.
4. Also restores eligibility for jury service, public office, and notary service.



WHY VOTE NO

1. **AUTOMATIC RESTORATION**
Eliminates requirements for accountability and restores voting rights immediately upon release—no proof of responsibility or rehabilitation.
2. **EQUAL TO THE MOST SERIOUS CRIMES**
Applies the same rule to violent offenders as to minor offenders, regardless of the severity of the crime.
3. **CREATES A CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT**
Locks in "voting rights" as a constitutional right that can be used to challenge future election laws in Virginia.
